POLICY ACTIVITY




- Federal initiatives relating to foodservice packaging largely paused, with the exception for the plastics registry

- Continued provincial extended producer responsibility program introduction, evolution, expansion and harmonization efforts



POLICY ACTIVITY

- Longer state sessions may provide greater opportunities for the passage of proposals


2025 STATE LEGISLATIVE LANDSCAPE

~180 proposed pieces of legislation relating to FSP in **30** states.





2025 STATE ACTIVITY POLICY AREAS

CANADA

- Federal plastics agenda remains dependent on court appeal as well as the upcoming election
- Provincial EPR introduction, implementation, and expansion will continue
- Potential for provincial action beyond EPR

UNITED STATES

- Federal agenda shift
- Continued state legislative activity: California, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Rhode Island
- Sustained and expanded regulatory activity
